## Crochet Pattern Polkadot Vase

Stitches used:

| Ch. | $=$ | Chain |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Sl.st. | $=$ | Slip Stitch |
| Sc. | $=$ | Single Crochet |
| Hdc. | $=$ | Half Double Crochet |
| Dc. | $=$ | Double Crochet |
| Trc. | $=$ | Triple Crochet |
| Tch. | $=$ | Turning Chain |

The number of stitches is displayed between ( ) at the end of each round.

Tip: it is useful to use a stitch ring marker to indicate the beginning of each round/round. This is put in the
 $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$. of the round, and is taken up each round.

## Materials:

Crochet hook 2 mm
Crochet hook 3,5mm
Crochet hook 4mm
Stitch ring markers
Stuffing

PVC pipe 125 mm
Piece of cardboard to cut a circle of $\varnothing 12,4 \mathrm{~cm}$ (see pattern chart)

4 balls Lana Grossa Cotton mix 80 colour 521

1 ball Phildar cotton 4 Meringue 78
1 ball Phildar cotton 3 Meringue 78

## Vase

The whole vase is made of Lana Grossa Cotton Mix 80 and crochet hook no. 4 mm . The decorative edge on the top is made with Phildar cotton 4 and crochet hook 3,5mm. The polkadots with Phildar cotton 3 and crochet hook no. 2 mm .

Start on the bottom of the vase.

Round 1: $\quad$ With colour 521 sc .6 in a magic ring or start the following way; Ch. $2, \mathrm{sc} .6$ in the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch} .$, sl.st. 1 in the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$. (6).
Round 2: Sc. 2 in each st. (12).

Round 3: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each $2^{\text {nd }}$ st. (18).
Round 4: $\quad$ Sc. 1, *sc. 2 in the next st., sc. 2*. Repeat *to * until the end of the round but end with sc. 1 (24).
Round 5: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each $4^{\text {th }}$ st. (30).
Round 6: Sc. 2, *sc. 2 in the next st., sc. 4*. Repeat *to * until the end of the round but end with sc. 2 ( 36 ).
Round 7: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each $6^{\text {th }}$ st. (42).
Round 8: Sc. 3, *sc. 2 in the next st., sc. 6*. Repeat *to * until the end of the round but end with sc. 3 (48).
Round 9: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each $8^{\text {th }}$ st. (54).
Round 10: Sc. $4,{ }^{*}$ sc. 2 in the next st., sc. 8*. Repeat *to * until the end of the round but end with sc. 4 (60).
Round 11: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each $10^{\text {th }}$ st. (66).
Round 12: Work this round in the back loops such that single loops are created on the outside of your work. Sc. 66 (66).
Rounds 13-31: $\quad$ Sc. 66 each round (66).
Round 32: $\quad$ Work this round in the back loops such that single loops are created on the outside of your work. Decrease 6 sts. Sc. each $10^{\text {th }}$ and $11^{\text {th }}$ sc. tog. (60).
Round 33: Sc. 60 (60). Do not cast off. Insert a stitch ring marker in the last st. and leave a long thread on your work to continue with later on.

Cast on a new yarn in the outside loops of round 32. Insert your hook from bottom to top.
Round 1: Sc. 66 (66).
Round 2: Work this round in the back loops such that single loops are created on the outside of your work. Sc. 66 (66).
Round 3: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each 11 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ st. (72)
Round 4: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each 12 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ st. (78).
Round 5: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each $13^{\text {th }}$ st. (84). Cast off and weave in the ends.
Cast on a new yarn in the outside loops of round 12. Insert your hook from bottom to top.
Round 1: $\quad$ Sc. $5,{ }^{*}$ sc. 2 in the next st., sc. 10*. Repeat *to * until the end of the round but end with sc. 5 (72).
Round 2: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each $12^{\text {th }}$ st. (78).
Round 3: $\quad$ Sc. 78 (78).
Round 4: Sc. 6, *sc. 2 in the next st., sc. 12*. Repeat *to * until the end of the round but end with sc. 6 (84).
Round 5: $\quad$ Sc. 84 (84).
Round 6: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each $14^{\text {th }}$ st (90).
Rounds 7-12: Sc. 90 each round (90).
Round 13: $\quad$ Decrease 6 sts. Sc. each $14^{\text {th }}$ and $15^{\text {th }}$ st. tog. (84).
Rounds 14 and 15: $\quad$ Sc. 84 each round (84).
Round 16: Decrease 6 sts. Sc. each $13^{\text {th }}$ and $14^{\text {th }}$ st. tog. (78).
Round 17: Sc. 78 (78).
Round 18: $\quad$ Decrease 6 sts. Sc. each $12^{\text {th }}$ and $13^{\text {th }}$ st. tog. (72).
Round 19: Decrease 6 sts. Sc. each $11^{\text {th }}$ and $12^{\text {th }}$ st. tog. (66).

Rounds 20-29: Sc. 66 each round. Insert a stitch ring marker in the last st. and leave the yarn on your work.

Take the yarn on the inside of the vase at round 33 . Stuff the vase but make sure it keeps its shape.

Insert the pvc pipe on the inside of your vase and continue at round 33. Work a round of sl.st. This way the pipe will remain in the vase. Cast off and weave in the ends.

Continue on the outside of your vase.

Round 30: $\quad$ Work this row in the single loops of round 32. Sc. 66 (66).
Round 31: Sc. 66 (66).
Round 32: Sc. 5, *sc. 2 in the next st., sc. 10*. Repeat *to * until the end of the round but end with sc. 5 (72).
Round 33: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each $12^{\text {th }}$ st. (78).
Round 34: Sc. 6, *sc. 2 in the next st., sc. 12*. Repeat *to * until the end of the round but end with sc. 6 (84).
Round 35: $\quad$ Work this round in the inside of round 5 of the vase. Sc. 84 (84).
Round 36: Sc. 2 in each $14^{\text {th }}$ st. (90). Cast off and weave in the ends.

## Decorative edge:

Cast on a new colour of Phildar Phil Coton 4 with crochet hook no. 3,5 in round 36.

Round 1:
Sc. 90 (90).
Round 2: *Sc. 1, hdc. 3, sc. 1 in the first st., skip 1 st., sl.st. 1 in the next st.* Repeat *to* until the end of the round. Cast off and weave in the ends.

## Polka dots:

Work with crochet hook 2 and Phildar Phil Coton 3.

Round 1: $\quad$ Sc. 6 in a magic ring or start the following way;
Ch. 2 , sc. 6 in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch., sl.st. 1 in the $1^{\text {st }}$ sc. (6).
Round 2: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each st. (12).
Round 3: $\quad$ Sc. 2 in each $2^{\text {nd }}$ st. (18). Cast off and leave a little yarn on the polka dot to attach it on the vase later on.

Work 12 polka dots this way. Divide the dots on your vase and attach them with a few little sts.

On the inside of the pvc pipe there is a little edge. Glue the cardboard circle on it. When you finish a flower you can cut a hole in the circle and insert the flower in it. This way the flowers will stand up firmly.
